City Tournament Selection Guidelines
Spring 2006

Invitations to represent each of the Alamo Heights Leagues in the City Tournament will be extended as follows:

A. If a League is not divided into Divisions. If a League is not divided into Divisions, two teams will be invited to the City Tournament.

1. The team with the best regular season record (the “Season Champion”) will receive an automatic invitation to the City Tournament.
2. The team that wins the AH Tournament (the “World Series Champion”) will receive the other automatic invitation to the City Tournament.
3. If the Season Champion and the World Series Champion are the same team, then the team that is the runner-up in the AH Tournament will also receive an automatic invitation to the City Tournament.
4. If one or more teams decline their invitations to the City Tournament, then invitations will be extended to the remaining teams in the order of their finish for the regular season until the available invitations are accepted.
5. Each team playing in the City Tournament may add up to two players from the other teams in its League that are not playing in the City Tournament as long as the resulting number of players on the team does not exceed the maximum number of players allowed on a City Tournament team as determined by District 19 rules. The Season Champion is entitled to the 1st and 4th picks. The other City Tournament team is entitled to the 2nd and 3rd picks.
6. The World Series Champion is entitled to choose its bracket in the City Tournament.

B. If a League is divided into two Divisions. If a League is divided into two Divisions, four teams (two from each Division) will be invited to the City Tournament.

1. The two teams with the best regular season records in each of their respective Divisions (the “Season Champions”) will each receive an automatic invitation to the City Tournament.

2. The two teams that win their respective Division Tournaments will each receive an automatic invitation to the City Tournament.
3. If a Division's Season Champion is the same team as the winner of the Division's Tournament, then the team that is the runner-up in the Division's Tournament will also receive an invitation to the City Tournament.
4. If one or more teams in a Division decline their invitations to the City Tournament, then invitations will be extended to the remaining teams in that Division in the order of their finish for the regular season until the available invitations are accepted.
5. Each team playing in the City Tournament may add up to two players from the other teams in its Division that are not playing in the City Tournament as long as the resulting number of players on the team does not exceed the maximum number of players allowed on a City Tournament team as determined by District 19 rules. The Season Champions are entitled to the 1st and 4th picks from their respective Divisions. The other City Tournament Teams are entitled to the 2nd and 3rd picks from their respective Divisions.
6. To the extent bracket choices for the City Tournament are available, bracket choices will be made in the following order:
 - a. The winner of the World Series is the first team to choose its bracket.
 - b. The runner up of the World Series is the second team to choose its bracket.
